****Balboa Park Tour (OPTIONAL afternoon event)**

Balboa Park, named after Spanish explorer Vasco Nunez de Balboa, was declared a National Historic Landmark in 1977. Balboa Park's many attractions are listed below.

- THE TRAM in the Park

The summer tram hours of operation are 9:30 AM-8:00 PM daily, through October 31.

Trams pick up from Tram Central every 8-10 minutes (at peak times, 20-40 minutes). Riders may also board at one of the designated pick-up areas around the Park. Make your first stop the Balboa Park Visitors Center (stop 1 after Tram Central) in the House of Hospitality where you can pick up a bi-monthly Events Guide and a detailed map.

USS Midway Museum

Group Meet-and-Greet with tour

Parts of the aircraft carrier are NOT ADA accessible.

The USS Midway was the longest-serving aircraft carrier in the 20th century. Named after the climatic Battle of Midway of June 1942.

The USS Midway has more than 30 restored aircraft and helicopters on display, spanning the decades from the Battle of Midway in 1942, the Korean and Vietnam Wars, to today's tactical aircraft. Carefully restored, each one represents an aspect of the USS Midway's long career.

The Midway offers a self-guided audio tour (2-4 hours), including the flight deck, hanger deck, and below-deck areas.
