

IF YOU WOULD LIKE COPIES OF ANY OF THESE PHOTOS I WOULD BE PLEASED TO SEND THEM TO YOU. LET ME HAVE YOUR NAME, ADDRESS AND THE NUMBER OF THE PHOTO OR PHOTOS YOU WANT (LOOK ON THE BACK OF THE PHOTO) AND I WILL GET THEM OFF TO YOU IMMEDIATELY. I HOPE YOU WILL SHARE WITH ME ANY STORIES, REMEMBRANCES, INFORMATION OR THOUGHTS YOU MAY HAVE ON TRUK RAIDS, MY FATHER COL. BURNHAM ANYTHING AND EVERYTHING RELATED TO THE MEN OF THE 307<sup>TH</sup>. THANK YOU VERY MUCH AND NOW IT IS TIME FOR ME TO BEGIN WRITING.

PARTICULAR THANKS TO JIM AND ALL OF YOU THAT HAVE ALREADY CONTACTED ME. THE STORIES ARE VERY MOVING. MY FATHER DIED WHEN I WAS YOUNG AND YOU HAVE HELPED ME GET TO KNOW HIM BETTER.




View of S-2, 868th "Snoopers", Munda, New Georgia. (April 1944)






